Under his leadership, the College of Fine Arts has enriched its programming in music, theatre, dance, film and the visual arts.

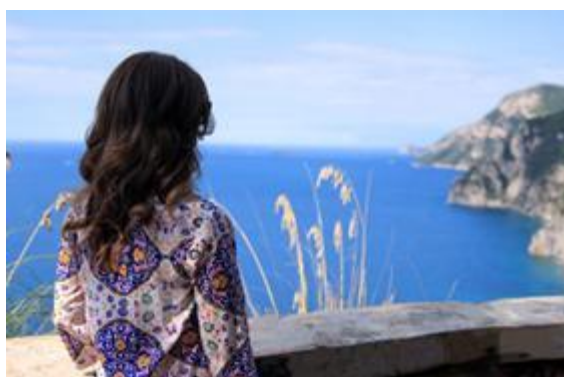


President Tim Cost '81 and Bryan Cranston Take the Florida Forum Stage

Excellence in Theatre Arts

Two of our productions were honored by the Kennedy Center American College Theater Festival this month: *String*, directed by Prof. Erik DeCicco, and *Into the Woods*, directed by Prof. Kimberly Beasley.

Carlos Adorno '20, was awarded the national David Mark Cohen award for playwriting. Carlos' prestigious award comes with a trip to Washington D.C. and a residency at the Kennedy Center, which will afford him the opportunity to connect with industry professionals, work on his play scripts, and network with peers from across the country.

Professor DeCicco '05 was also recognized for Excellence in Directing for his contribution to the production of *String*. The David Mark Cohen award is awarded only to playwrights whose work has been selected for production by the student's university - Professor DeCicco and Carlos have been working on the script and subsequent production of *String* for nearly two years - Carlos has been working on the script for nearly three.
