

Office of Financial Aid FLORIDA RESIDENCY DOCUMENTATION

The State of Florida has instituted new regulations for all colleges/universities which require us to obtain proof of permanent Florida Residency from one Parent* if their student receives or will receive any Florida Financial Aid Funding. This includes the FRAG, FSAG, Bright Futures and other state programs.

*If no Parental information was required on the FAFSA please submit the information for yourself (Independent Students)

Please provide us with copies of ANY TWO (2) of the following documents:

Each Document Must Be Dated or Issued at least 12 months prior to the initial start of enrollment at Jacksonville University or receipt of any Florida Aid from Jacksonville University

- 1. Florida Voter's Registration
- 2. Florida Driver's License (please see the note below about faxing the license)
- 3. Florida Identification Card
- 4. Florida Vehicle Registration
- 5. Florida Homestead Exemption
- 6. Proof of Full-time Employment, at least 30 hours per week for 12 month period
- 7. Florida Professional or Occupational License
- 8. Florida Incorporation Document
- 9. Official State, Federal or Court Document evidencing legal ties to Florida

Members of the Armed Service of the United States on active military duty pursuant to military orders or whose home of record is Florida may provide:

- A copy of your military orders or DD2058 showing home of record, AND
- For a Spouse, a copy of your marriage license
- For a dependent child, a copy of the dependents birth certificate

Please submit this information with your student's name and id number. You can send it by email attachment, regular mail, in person, or via fax (904)256-7148. (Note: You must lighten the copy of the driver's license before faxing it in order for it to be legible.) Please be sure all dates and signatures on your copies are legible. We reserve the right to request additional documents in the event the documents submitted are not legible, not dated or insufficient to make a determination of permanent residency.
