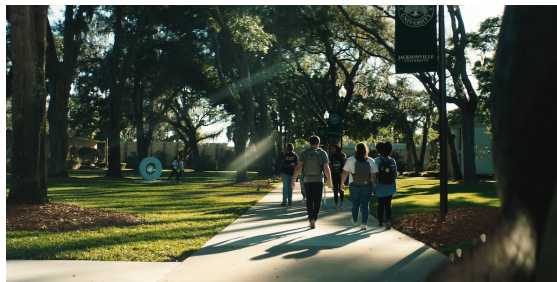


College of Law Celebrates with Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony

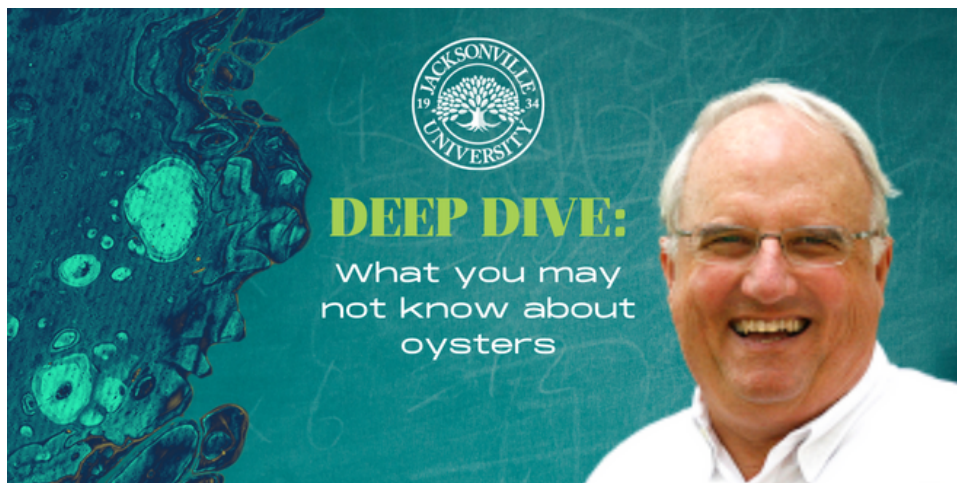
U.S. World & News Report Ranks JU Among Best Universities in the South
